CPPP provides a single point access to all the tendering information on various procurements made across the country.

#### It facilitates:

ePublishing - Publishing of tender enquiries, corrigendum & award of contract details

XML - Facilitates publishing of tender comprehensive information of other eProcurement system

eProcurement - Facilitated through - GePNIC® implemented in around 700 + Central Government Ministries / Departments and Public Sector Units, it is also being rolled out across India in 31 State Government /Union Territories.




## Percentage share of Tender Category / Tender Type for GePNIC®

DG, NIC, addressed the audience highlighting the key features of the CPP Portal, including transparency, security, and confidentiality of data, and how the portal has evolved over time. He also emphasized how the CPP Portal and GeM complement each other, and that the workshop would provide an ideal platform for speakers to share their experiences and users to give their feedback, ideas, and suggestions. Finally, he conveyed his best wishes for the success of the workshop and congratulated all the awardees for their exceptional achievements.

The workshop was attended by representatives from 28 States, 8 Union Territories and 75 Central Govt. Organisations, all related to the domain. The presence of officials from varied procuring entitieshelped in making this workshop a great success.


