## Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP)

Central Public Procurement Portal provides a single point access to all the tendering information on various procurement made across the country. It is integrated with Government eMarketplace and is called as GeM-CPPP. It hosts the Government eProcurement System (GePNIC®) for electronic procurement developed by National Informatics Centre in close coordination with Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.

## It facilitates

**ePublishing:** Publishing of tender enquiries, corrigendum & award of contract details.

**XML:** Facilitates publishing the metadata of tenders published by organisations using varied eProcurement System.

**GeM Bids:** All the bids published on Government eMarket Place is also shown here.

**eProcurement:** Complete gamut of Procurement Goods, Works and Services including Global Tenders, Pre-Post integrations and is implemented in around 800+ Central Government Ministries / Departments and Public Sector Units, it is also used in 31 State Government/Union Territories for online tendering. Many World Bank and ADB tenders are processed using this GePNIC® platform.

(Sixth Round)

Mementos gifted to Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi during various programs and events across India are being auctioned on <https://pmmementos.gov.in> from 17<sup>th</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> October. A total of 602 items were available for bidding.

This marks the sixth consecutive year of these auctions, conducted using the eAuction India platform developed by NIC. The platform offers advanced features, including:

- Image and video displays of auction items for enhanced visibility.
- Dedicated sections such as "Highlighted Items," "Be the First to Bid," and "Most Participated Auctions."

The proceeds from these auctions will support the 'Namami Gange' initiative—a Central Government project dedicated to cleaning and rejuvenating the River Ganga.

# Highlights of the financial year 2024-25

## AIMA- Global Procurement Summit 2025

Director General, Shri IPS Sethi, NIC addressed the plenary session "Streamlining Procurement Processes for Greater Efficiency", emphasizing NIC eProcurement system GePNIC on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2025 at the Global Procurement Summit 2025, organized by All India Management Association (AIMA), in collaboration with the Ministry of Finance, Government of India and World Bank India, in New Delhi. The summit was attended by procurement practitioners across Government, CPSEs and delegates from various countries.



## Visit of Sri Lankan Delegation to Understand Government eProcurement System of NIC (GePNIC®)



A delegation from Sri Lanka visited New Delhi on September 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 2024. In this program, NIC delivered sessions on various topics such as the Enabling Policy Framework for e-GP, Infrastructure, Deployment, and Instances Management and also provided a demonstration and walk-through of the eProcurement system.

On September 5<sup>th</sup> 2024, delegations from Nepal visited India for the knowledge exchange program on eProcurement organized by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) at new delhi. NIC delivered a session focusing on the features of Government eProcurement System of NIC (GePNIC®) including security features for safeguarding against the compromise of bids, the bid submission and evaluation process, coverage of GePNIC®, how it works for MDB-financed projects, and lessons that can be learnt from India's experience.

Soft Launch of Project Information & Cost Estimation (PRICE) - Government eProcurement System of NIC. The integration of GePNIC (Pre & Post Tender Module) was inaugurated by Shri Gyanesh Bharti, IAS, Commissioner of MCD, at Dr. S.P. Mukherjee Civic Centre on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2024. The event was attended by the NIC-GePNIC team, Delhi officials, and the MCD team. This integration with the GePNIC-PRICE application marks a landmark initiative to establish an end-to-end online process for project estimation and tendering, streamlining government eProcurement workflows.




## Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) Adopts CPPP-GePNIC® for e-Procurement
