CENTRAL PUBLIC PROCUREMENT PORTAL (CPPP)

Central Public Procurement Portal provides a single point access to all the tendering information on various procurement made across the country. It is integrated with Government eMarketplace and is called as GeM-CPPP. It hosts the Government eProcurement System (GePNIC®) for electronic procurement developed by National Informatics Centre in close coordination with Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.

IT FACILITATES

EUBLISHING:

Publishing of tender enquiries, corrigendum & award of contract details.

GEM BIDS:

All the bids published on Government eMarket Place is also shown here.

XML:

Facilitates publishing the metadata of tenders published by organisations using varied eProcurement System.

EPROCUREMENT:

Complete gamut of Procurement Goods, Works and Services including Global Tenders, Pre-Post integrations and is implemented in around 800+ Central Government Ministries / Departments and Public Sector Units, it is also used in 31 State Government/Union Territories for online tendering. Many World Bank and ADB tenders are processed using this GePNIC® platform.

The platform enhances transparency, efficiency, and accountability through end-to-end electronic tendering. By enabling wider bidder participation and competitive procurement, it strengthens NTPC's commitment to digital governance. Overall, the portal plays a crucial role in advancing reliable, efficient, and sustainable power sector operations.

SUMMARY – ACTS & RULES FOR NTPC TENDERING PORTAL




- General Financial Rules (GFR) 2017 – Forms the core procurement framework for NTPC, outlining principles of competition, transparency, financial prudence, and fair bidding.
- Manuals of Procurement (Goods, Works & Consultancy) – Issued by the Ministry of Finance; standardize procedures for tendering, evaluation, and contract award across all government entities.
- Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) Guidelines – Mandate integrity, anti-corruption measures, vigilance checks, and fair evaluation processes in all tenders.
- IT Act, 2000 & IT (Amendment) Act, 2008 – Provide legal backing for electronic tendering, digital signatures, electronic records, bid encryption, and online contract documentation.
- NTPC Purchase Procedures & Internal Procurement Policies – Define NTPC-specific controls, approval authorities, documentation standards, and workflow for Goods, Services, and Works.
- Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order (PPP-MII) – Ensures priority to domestic manufacturers and suppliers, supporting self-reliance and government initiatives.
- MSME Act & Related Procurement Rules – Provide procurement benefits and mandatory participation opportunities to Micro & Small Enterprises.
